

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
March 26th, 2019

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a special meeting was duly held in the Adams Health Care Center activities room on the 26th day of March, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

Council present: Brian Anderson, Michael Cherney, Paul Kirtz, Karen Ruechel, and Peter Schmitz.

Mayor Brian Anderson presided at the meeting.

Discussion was held on hiring a police chief or contracting with Mower County Sherriff's Department to provide police protection for the City of Adams. A motion was made by Paul Kirtz, seconded by Mike Cherney, directing the City Clerk put ads out accepting applications for a Chief of Police and a part time police officer. Votes in favor: Cherney, Kirtz, Ruechel, and Schmitz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

City Council member Karen Ruechel reported that the City of Rose Creek will be discussing contracting for police services of the Adams Police Department at their regular Council meeting in April. Karen is also setting up a meeting with Elkton to see if they would like to contract for police services.

City Clerk Jim Kiefer was directed to have the locks changed on the front and back doors of City Hall. Jim was also directed to contact the Post Board to insure that the interim police chief is in place and that Mike Gehrke has summited the paper work for his retirement.
