

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

June 27th, 2023

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a special meeting was duly held at City Hall at 5:30 PM on the 27th day of June 2023.

Agenda:

Approval of Minutes:

Old Business:

The clerk presented a strip of green space that could possibly work as the site for a Veterans Memorial here in the City of Adams located at the Emergency Services Building. The space is approximately 12' wide by 45' long. The clerk was advised to talk to members from the American Legion to gather input to see if this spot would be sufficient.

The clerk informed the council that the new shower house being built in the Adams City Park will be open to the public starting July 1st.

Building Permits:

Motion made by Karen Ruechel, seconded by Ella Noterman to approve a building permit to Charlie Gilles to construct a 12' x 14' storage building on the NW corner of his property. Marijuana Dispensary:

Robert Retterath approached the city council with the idea of starting a dispensary to sell recreational marijuana within the city limits of Adams. The City has passed an ordinance pertaining to the sale of edible cannabinoid products but has yet to pass an ordinance regarding the sale of recreational marijuana after the State of Minnesota passed a bill legalizing the use of recreational marijuana after July 31st. The clerk was going to get input from the city attorney regarding an ordinance for the City of Adams and get back to Mr. Retterath with the information that he had gathered.
