Sergeant Tim Donovan attended the council meeting to discuss the police report for June. He stated that the Mower County Sheriffs Department completed had 142 patrol hours and responded to 30 calls within the City of Adams. Sergeant Donovan also requested a list of ordinances from the city. The clerk will work on getting him a list.

Fire Department Report:

Chief Dillon Heimer was present at the meeting to discuss the Fire Department Report for the month of June. He stated that fire department responded to 5 calls in the month of June. Three shed fires, a medical assist and a car fire. Dillon also asked that Jake Mandler be removed from the department's roster. The council requested that Dillon get either a Resignation Letter or a signed Termination Letter from Mr. Mandler.

Maintenance Department Report:

The maintenance department has been working in the park on the new campground sites. All electrical utilities have been installed and the next step will be building the pads for the campsites. The department has also been busy in the North Side Park 2nd Addition trying to level dirt, pick up rocks and sticks and spreading seed to get some vegetation to grow. Roads were crack sealed and will hopefully be seal coated within the next couple of days. They have also been working with the new RTK equipment purchased to get the valves, hydrants, manholes, ect. located and mapped within the City of Adams.
