

EMERGENCY CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 3rd, 2016

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof an emergency meeting was duly held at City Hall on the 3rd day of June 3rd, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.

Council present: Mark Anderson, Gail Anderson, Paul Kirtz, and Peter Schmitz.

Council absent: Barry Kurtz.

Mayor Mark Anderson presided at the meeting.

Water Superintendent Craig Hegge updated the City Council on the condition of City well #2. The contractor hired to seal well #1 and rehab well #2 (Mineral Services) has videotaped well #2 and determined that the well is in very poor condition. It was hoped that well #2 could be rehabbed and used as an emergency well for the City. Mineral Services representative recommends the well be sealed rather than spend money to rehab. The casing is in very poor condition and there is no guarantee that the well will produce drinkable water after the rehab. The well was constructed in 1897 and tests show the well has nitrates. Craig Hegge recommended sealing the well and looking into constructing a new well for the City of Adams.

Motion made by Paul Kirtz, seconded by Gail Anderson directing the City Clerk to contact the Minnesota Department of Health and request that the grant funding received be used to seal City Well #2 rather than using the well as an emergency well. Votes in favor: G. Anderson, Kirtz, Schmitz, and M. Anderson. Votes against: None Motion carried
