

REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
April 10th, 2012

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a regular meeting was duly held at City Hall at 7:00 PM on the 10th day of April, 2012.

Council present: Rick Hinz, Mark Anderson, Paul Kirtz, and Barry Kurtz.

Council absent: LeRoy Swanson.

Assistant Mayor Rick Hinz presided at the meeting.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Kirtz, to approve the March 13th, and March 27th, 2012 minutes as recorded. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kirtz, and Kurtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Michael Gehrke presented the March, 2012 police report. The report lists 6 state citations, 2 city administrative citations, 5 warning tickets, 1 outside agency assist, and 1 Fire/Ambulance assist.

Lynn Lagerstedt addressed the city Council with concerns over the calculation of the proposed assessment of 219 5th Street NW. Lynn requested the council reconsider the amount being assessed for replacement of the water line on Lewison Street. The parcel Lynn is concerned about is hooked to the water line on 5th Street. Rick Hinz assured Lynn that he would pass on the information to the City Engineer. The City Engineer is calculating all of the assessments along the 2012 street project. A public hearing will be held in late summer to review all of the assessments proposed by the City Engineer.

City Clerk Jim Kiefer informed the council that the Fire department has completed the controlled burn in the City Park, the burn area will be used for the Civil War re-enactment this summer.

The bills payable were reviewed.

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Kirtz, to approve payment of bills as submitted. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kirtz, and Kurtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

The city clerk presented the February 29th, 2012 financial statements. Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Anderson, to approve the financial statement as presented. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kurtz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

The Prairie Visions report was presented by Jim Kiefer. The March 26th, 2012 meeting was held in the Rose Creek City Hall. A trail sweeper has been purchased for \$2000.00. The sweeper is installed on the City of Adams John Deere tractor. The annual Shooting Star Trail Bike Ride has been set for July 14th, 2012. The bike ride will begin in the City of Rose Creek this year.

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Anderson, to approve a building permit to Patrick Staples (109 West Main Street) for construction of a 24' X 32' garage. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kirtz, and Kurtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Anderson, to approve a one day raffle permit to the Adams Town & Country Recreation Corporation. Raffle drawing will be held June 10th, 2012 in the Adams American Legion Club. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, Kirtz. Votes against: Kurtz Motion carried.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Kurtz, to approve a one day bingo permit to the Adams Town & Country Recreation Corporation. Bingo will be conducted June 10th, 2012 in the Adams American Legion Club. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kurtz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Jim Kiefer informed the council that the Mower County League of Cities dinner meeting will be held April 26th, 2012 in the Mower County Senior Center.

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Kirtz, to adjourn. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kurtz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.
