

REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 11th, 2013

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a regular meeting was duly held at City Hall at 7:00 PM on the 14th day of May, 2013.

Council present: LeRoy Swanson, Mark Anderson, Rick Hinz, and Paul Kirtz.

Council absent: Barry Kurtz.

Public Hearing for Flood Plain Ordinance.

Mayor Swanson opened the Public Hearing for discussion on the proposed food plain ordinance. No citizens were present for the hearing. A motion made by Hinz, seconded by Kirtz, to approve Adams Flood Plain Ordinance #179. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None
Motion carried.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Kirtz, to approve the May 14th, 2013 council minutes as recorded. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Michael Gehrke presented the April, 2013 police report. The report lists 2 criminal arrests, 1 traffic accident, 4 state citations, 2 city administrative citations, 26 warning tickets, 3 ambulance/fire assists, and 3 outside agency assists. Mike reported that he participated in the SE MN emergency communications drill last month.

Considerable discussion was held on removing unlicensed vehicles from the City limits. Mike was also directed to enforce the Ordinance pertaining to outside storage of materials on private property.

The bills payable were reviewed.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Hinz, to approve payment of bills as submitted. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

The city clerk presented the April 30th, 2013 financial statements. Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Hinz, to approve the financial statement as presented. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Anderson, to approve building permits to Willem DeHoogh (405 Bergen St.) for construction of a screened porch, Sherry Gilman (306 Bergen St) for placement of a wrought iron fence, John Logsdon (302 Bergen St) for a garage/work shop, Verizon Wireless (20 Commerce St) for placement of two antennas, and to the Boys Scouts for placement of four duck houses along the river. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

A request was submitted from Adams Builders Supply to credit their utilities bill for the amount of water usage to water plants during the summer months. The request was denied due to lack of a motion.

A request was submitted by Russell Retterath to clean the road ditch along Krebsbach Street, north of Vangsness Street. The request was denied due to lack of a motion.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Hinz, to approve an allocation of \$10,000.00 from the capital outlay account for rebuilding manholes in the city limits. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Anderson, to adjourn. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.
