

## REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

July 10th, 2012

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a regular meeting was duly held at City Hall at 7:00 PM on the 10th day of July, 2012.

Council present: LeRoy Swanson, Mark Anderson, Rick Hinz, and Paul Kirtz.

Council absent: Barry Kurtz.

Mayor LeRoy Swanson presided at the meeting.

Motion made by Hinz, seconded by Kirtz, to approve the June 12<sup>th</sup>, and June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012 minutes as recorded. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Michael Gehrke presented the June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012 police report. The report lists 4 state citations, 3 city administration citations, 9 warning tickets, 2 traffic accidents, 4 outside agency assists, 3 Fire/Ambulance assists, and 1 criminal arrest. Mike informed the City Council that he has received nine applications for the part-time police position. The City Council commended Chief Gehrke for his actions in preventing a burglary at the Cedar River golf course. Rick Hinz relayed a message from the Cedar River Board of Directors expressing their appreciation of Chief Gehrke's actions the night of the attempted burglary.

Jim Kiefer presented the Fire department report for June, 2012. Two calls including a baler fire, and a fuel tank spill were reported in June. Mark Anderson reported that 15 radios will be ordered for the Fire Department and the Ambulance Service. Funds from a Mower County grant will pay for the radios.

The bills payable were reviewed.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Kirtz, to approve payment of bills as submitted. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

The city clerk presented the May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012 financial statements. Motion made by Hinz, seconded by Anderson, to approve the financial statement as presented. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

The Prairie Visions report was presented by Jim Kiefer. The June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012 meeting was held in the Rose Creek City Hall. A ribbon cutting ceremony for completion of the bike trail between Adams and Rose Creek was held at the Rose Creek trailhead. The annual Shooting Star Bike Ride will be held July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2012 beginning in Rose Creek.

Jim Kiefer reported that the curb and driveway cement work is completed on the 2012 street project. Ulland Bros will be placing the final gravel base along the project the end of this week. Blacktopping will begin next week. The project could be completed by the middle of July, dependent on good weather.

Discussion was held on adding camping spots to the city park. City Clerk Jim Kiefer was directed to obtain bids for placing electrical hookups for 6 camping sites along the west edge of the park.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Hinz, to enter into a three year contract with Mediacom for telephone and internet service for the City of Adams. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Hinz, to approve a one day raffle permit to the Southland Sportsmen's Club for a raffle to be held October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012 in the American Legion Club. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Kirtz, to adjourn. Votes in favor: Anderson, Hinz, and Kirtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.
