

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
October 22nd, 2013

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a special meeting was duly held at the Adams Health Care Center Activities room on the 22nd day of October, 2013 at 4:30 p.m.

Council present: LeRoy Swanson, Rick Hinz, and Barry Kurtz.

Council absent: Paul Kirtz, Mark Anderson.

Mayor LeRoy Swanson presided at the meeting.

Kathi Finley, director Paint the Town Pink addressed the City Council. Paint the Town Pink is a fund raising organization dedicated to providing funds for the Hormel Institute Breast Cancer Research facility. Kathi requested the City of Adams become a "Paint the Town Pink Community".

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Hinz, to accept the bid from RDS Trucking Inc, Austin Mn, to remove snow from Hwy 56, and Mower County 7. RDS Trucking bid was \$95.00 per hour for a 3 ¾ yard loader and \$75.00 an hour for trucking. D & W Construction bid was \$97.50 for a 2 ¾ yard loader, and \$84.50 for trucking. Votes in favor: Kurtz, Hinz, and Swanson. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Hinz, seconded by Kurtz, to approve a water bill credit of ¼ of the excess water usage to Curt Hamilton due to a water leak in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. This was Curt Hamilton's second leak in the past 5 years. Votes in favor: Hinz, Anderson, and Swanson. Apposed: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Hinz, to adjourn. Votes in favor: Swanson, Hinz, and Kurtz. Votes against: None Motion carried.
