

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
November 24th, 2015

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a special meeting was duly held at the Adams Health Care Center Activities room on the 24th day of November, 2015 at 4:30 p.m.

Council present: Mark Anderson, Gail Anderson, Barry Kurtz, Paul Kirtz, and Peter Schmitz.

Council absent: None.

Mayor Mark Anderson presided at the meeting.

Liquor license application by Shree Ji Bapa (400 W Main Street) was tabled for lack of paperwork. The City clerk will obtain the required paperwork for the next City Council meeting.

Discussion was held on approving a building permit to David Sathre for construction of an addition to his home at 206 4th St. SW. The City Clerk informed the council that the addition is close to floodplain restrictions. The City Clerk presented a letter from Ceil Strauss (DNR representative) stating the City Council could approve the permit for the addition as designed. Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by G. Anderson, to approve a building permit to David Sathre (206 4th St. SW) for construction of a 11' X 44' addition to his house. Votes in favor: G. Anderson, Kurtz, Kirtz, and Schmitz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kirtz, seconded by Kurtz, to approve a building permit to Green/Hyland DDS (407 Lincoln Street) for construction of a wheel chair ramp. Votes in favor: G. Anderson, Kurtz, Kirtz, and Schmitz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

Motion made by Kurtz, seconded by Schmitz, to approve Resolution #17-2015, a resolution to levy delinquent water, sewer, and garbage bills to property taxes. Votes in favor: Anderson, Kurtz, Kirtz, and Schmitz. Votes against: None Motion carried.

A complaint was received that snow has not been shoveled from in front of Young's Welding. City ordinance states that snow must be removed from City streets within 48 hours or the Maintenance Department will remove the snow and bill the owner of the property. The City Council will be sending a letter and copy of the ordinance to Mr. Young.

Motion made by Schmitz, seconded by Kirtz, to adjourn. Votes in favor: G. Anderson, Kirtz, Kurtz, and Schmitz. Votes against: None Motion carried
